Visionaries and Activists,

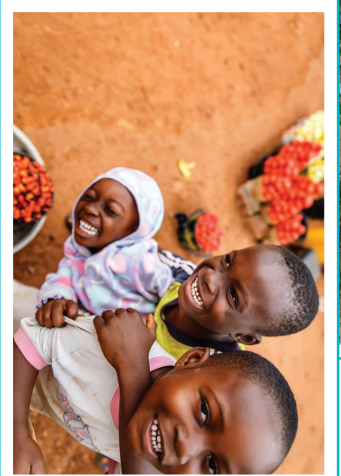

### October 2012

First fundraiser in Albany, OR casts vision for this project called "Farm in a Barrel."

### July 2013

10 Farm in a Barrel systems are shipped and launched in Ghana, West Africa.

### May 2014

The first two rounds of chickens raised with Farm in a Barrel are successful.

### December 2014

Truth x Vision moves into its first office and hires its first executive director.

### June 2015

Village Drill program is launched, employing a local team to bring clean water to thousands each year.

### August 2015

First official mission team of 7 individuals travel to Ghana, serving as the launch of Mission Month.
